geharloop het met twee booswigte op sy hakke.

Die polisie het 'n paar minute daarna opgedaag en die man veilig by sy huis gaan aflaai", het sy aan Die Hoorn vertel. Sy het verder gesê dat dit vir haar hartverskeurend is dat mense se lewens so in gevaar kan wees, en dit oor R70 wat die man op 'n eerlike en hardwerkende manier verdien het.

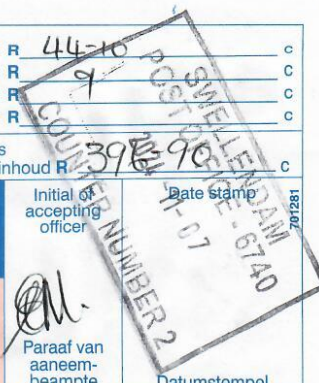

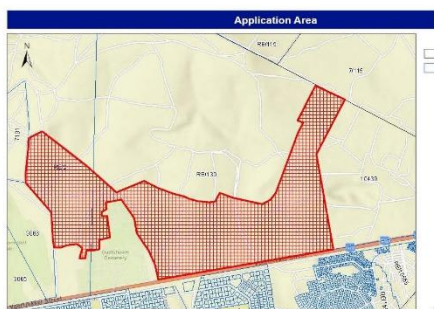
